

PORT OF TROON LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW AIDS TO NAVIGATION - CONSULTATION

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that it is proposed to establish four new Aids to Navigation (AtoNs) to mark the outer extremity of the Turning Circle to the North of Troon Harbour entrance.

It is proposed that the new AtoNs would be 1250mm diameter Port Hand Special Mark buoys as shown below. Each would be equipped with a light, Radar Reflector and GPS Synchronisation. It is proposed the light character of each buoy would be quick flashing with a range of 2-3nm. Flashing of the lights would be synchronised.



Approximate proposed positions of the new AtoNs are shown on the attached chartlet and the approximate positions are as follows:
